### **S - Scriptures**

### **C – Consideration**

Paul and Silas arrived in Philippi, in Macedonia. ### **C – Commitment**

How many times we are facing challenges, and trying to understand God’s will in the place where He has sent us on a mission. I remembered when I went to an island in the middle of the Atlantic on a mission. We saw the need of the people who were suffering under satanic oppression. They had not yet heard the gospel. We had such opposition and it seemed almost impossible to share the good news with them. But I knew that God had sent us there. I called my wife and we both climbed a hill out of the village, and there, in that solitary place, we both spent one hour in prayer. As we came down the hill, a man asked me if I could come and visit his family. We entered the house, and shared the gospel with them all. I baptized his father, and the following day we had a meeting attended by almost thirty people. When things look difficult, when problems look too big, when obstacles look unbearable, we must look for a place of prayer. There God will meet us, will give us peace, and will redirect our plans into his plans.

### **C – Call**

My God, we are in the midst of so many distractions of our days, even inside of our own homes, with floods of information, some false, some true. As a result, many times frustration, anger, despair, and other feelings inundate my soul. Help me to find the place of prayer; a place outside the city’s gate, where I can be alone with You.
